<u>Item No: 14.6: According approval of Inception of obtaining caution money from the students</u>

At present, there is no system of obtaining caution money from students of both the UG & PG courses in NIT, Arunachal Pradesh. The deduction of caution money is mainly made so as to manage any unforeseen case of damage that may be caused by the careless handling of instruments by the students in the laboratory or due to any accidents. The caution money would be used to compensate any loss or damage caused by the students. The amount of caution money will be deducted from each of the students of a particular academic year and the same would then be deposited in a separate saving bank account. Thereafter, suitable amount would be invested in fixed deposit schemes. This amount of caution money, if not utilized to meet any loss etc., would be returned to the students after their passing out from the institute.

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The amount of caution money will certainly fortify the internal revenue generation to a great extent. With the passage of time, this enhanced IRG would enable the Institute to become self-sufficient so as to meet any unforeseen situation that may arise in case of non-receipt of Grant-in-Aid from the Ministry in time or any other problems. However, this generation of internal revenue is to be monitored through a efficient system in the Institute.

It is proposed that the amount of caution money may be Rs. 1,000/- (One thousand only) payble as ONE-TIME fee at the time of admission with effect from 2016-17 session. The amount will be refundable after completion of course / withdrawal from Institute with Clearance from the departments/Institute.

Item No: 14.7: According approval of deposition of students' semester fees, registration charges examination fees, etc in a saving bank account and then investing in fixed deposit schemes

At present, amount received as semester fees, registration charges, examination fees etc. from the students are deposited in the Grant-in-Aid Account. This is a Current Account with the State Bank of India, Nirjuli Branch. However, the Mess money received from the students is being handled in a separate account.

The receipts from the students should start earning interest from the day when it is deposited in a bank. As the generation of Internal Revenue assumes as important issue in the present-day-scenario, the Institute is required to find out the Best Value Scheme which should be adopted for bolstering the IRG.

In the existing system, it is not possible to monitor the progress of generation of internal revenue through an effective plan of action of investment in gainful schemes. Moreover, that is a Current Account and thus, receipts from the students are not earning any interest after the same are deposited.

It is, therefore, proposed that all types of payments received from the students and also the Caution Money should be deposited in a Saving Bank Account at the first stage and thereafter, the process of investing the said amount in a Best value Fixed Deposit Scheme should start at the earliest.

BoG may like to consider & approve the same.

<u>Decision</u>: Approved as proposed. Director may approve further functional & operational procedures to be framed for the purpose.

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14.8: According approval of initiation of a system of payment of students fees etc. through a three-parts Bank Challan

Till date, the students' semester fees, registration fees, examination fees and other miscellaneous payments are received in the Institute itself through the "Payment Window" of the Office. It requires involvement of a dealing hand in the counter for a considerable period of the working hours. At the same time, maintenance of the payment receipts through different register warrants a huge time.

In most of the Institutes, these types of payments are received from the students through three parts Bank challans deposited in the bank. The Institute would collect necessary documents from the Bank at certain intervals and maintain the progress of receipt of funds from the students in its records. Thus, the system would ensure a smooth management of students' fees by the Institute. At the same time, any possibility of mismanagement of funds can be stopped/avoided.

A copy of three part Bank Challan is placed in Annex – 14.II

<u>Item No: 14.9: According approval of opening of an Employees' Welfare Co-operative Society in NIT-Arunachal Pradesh</u>

At present, there is no Employees' Welfare Co-operative Society in NIT, Arunachal Pradesh. The Welfare Society in an office is generally run on co-operative basis with subscriptions from all the employees. It will provide an effective source of financial relief to the hard-pressed employees in the event of any unfortunate and unforeseen situation. The funds from this society may be utilized for many other constructive purposes.

A Committee will be set up to manage this Welfare Society and the monthly subscriptions from each of the employees will be deducted from their salary bill. Amount of monthly subscription grant of loan from the fund of the Society to the employees and other formalities will be decided by the Committee in consultation with the Director.

Item No: 14.10: According approval of Implementation of Central Govt. Group Insurance Scheme for the regular employees of the Institute

The regular employees of this Institute has increased in number with the passage of time. The rule position in the above matter is placed at flag 'A'. The terms of membership are brought out hereunder:

- Member employees are enrolled as members of the Scheme only from 1st January every year. If an employee enters service on or after 2nd January in any year, he is enrolled as a member only from 1st January of the next year. From the actual date of appointment to 31st December, he will be entitled only to Insurance cover.
- 2. Earlier in last January, the matter was brought to the notice of the Director vide a note 19.01.2015 and the Director approved it and advised that the matter may be reported to the Finance Committee.
- 3. In this context, it may be mentioned that the matter was taken up with the LIC Office at Jorhat (vide Institute's letter dtd. 13.1.2015.). All the necessary details were also forwarded to them; but nothing has been heard till date.
- 4. This Group Insurance Scheme of 1980 is compulsory to all the Central Goyt, employees. The scheme is beneficial to the employees as it contains both the element of Insurance and Savings Fund. The rate of monthly subscription and amount of Insurance cover may please be seen at ANNEX - 14.III.
- 5. As the Institute has not yet received any reply from LIC, Jorhat Branch, the Office of the LIC, Naharlagun may be requested to accommodate this Institute in this regard. The DIC (F&A) may please be advised to approach LIC Office alongwith Ms. Momi Das to get the needful done immediately.
