NIT Arunachal Pradesh is in practice for Startup Grant to help ongoing research activities of the Institute as per the decision of the 10th meeting of Council of National Institutes of Technology, Science Education and Research (NITSER) held on 26th May, 2017 at IIAS, Shimla, at Annex-III under item no: 1.7 on recommendations of Dr. Vijay Thadani Committee on Research Pathways for NITs [Annex- 22.X, Page No: 108 to 109]. Earlier this facility was given to the Department rather than given to Faculty Member without any formal guidelines. Now following guidelines are proposed to continue the Startup Grant.

- The grant will be given to newly joining faculty members to encourage for starting I. research.
- Faculty member joining within last 3 (three) years and having no sponsored project will be II. admissible.
- Maximum admissible startup grant will be upto Rs. 3 (three) lakhs for each faculty III. member.
- A newly joined faculty member apply for the startup grant with a research proposal to IV. Dean(R&D).
- A committee will evaluate & recommend the proposal. V.
- If needed the newly joined faculty member may apply with the help of a Sr. faculty VI. member.
- The grant will be allowed for a maximum period of two years. VII.

Item No: 22.10: According approval of hiring Professor and Associate Professor under various Departments in view of NBA Accreditation.

NIT Arunachal Pradesh started functioning since the year 2010 with B.Tech courses in Mechanical, Civil, Electrical Engineering, CSE, ECE, Chemical Engineering and Biotechnology. The institute offers 6 M.Tech and 2 Master of Science courses. More than 60 PhD students are also engaged in research so far. However, the academic and research and development of the institute is still at its infancy due to lack of experienced faculty. Except the department of Mechanical Engineering, there is no Professor in any of the departments. Thus for the growth of the core Engineering Departments and also for the NBA accreditation, senior faculty members at the level of Associate Professor/Professor is required immediately. Hardly few applications are received for core engineering departments for such positions in the recent advertisement. One major problem for not getting experienced faculty may be due to the remote location of the

To improve the academics and research as well to guide the young faculty members, extra efforts have been taken to persuade retired professors/scientist from reputed institutions to join the institute on contract basis in the department of Mechanical, Electronics and Communication and Electrical Engineering. Following are the summery of the applications received:

1. Professor Sankar Nath Shome (DOB 28th February, 1958): Professor Shome superannuated as Chief Scientist on 28th February 2018 from CSIR-CMERI Durgapur. He obtained M.Tech degree from IIT Kanpur and PhD from NIT Durgapur. His area of specialization includes autonomous under water vehicle, mobile robots and remotely operated vehicles. He played a major role in conceiving and designing the first postgraduate level academic programme (M.Tech) in Mechatronics in CSIR-CMERI. Under his leadership several externally funded projects had been completed. He had contributed for the design and development of mobile robotics for visual inspection,

robotics system for nuclear power plant and underwater application for different agencies such as IGCAR, Kalpakam, TATA Steel etc. He has a patent which is granted in the year 2012 and 03 more patents have been filed. He has published 1 book on "Advanced Manufacturing and Robotics" and 76 nos. of papers. His vast experience in the specialization of design, robotics and Mechatronics will help the Mechanical Department to boost academic as well as research activities.

- 2. Professor Bidyut Kumar Bhattacharyya (DOB 8th October, 1955) Professor Bhattacharyya had completed his Ph.D from State University of New York at Buffalo, NY, USA in 1983 and M.Sc in Physics from IIT, Kanpur, India in 1978. Since 1984 he is associated with Intel Corporation, Chandler, Arizona, USA. During his 30years tenure at Intel Corporation he has worked in designing electrical packages for high performance applications and developed first to market product with high volume manufacturability. Further, during his stay at Intel corporation, Hillsboro, USA he has worked on Optical interconnect and Copper interconnect in PCB board to understand whether data can be send at 20-50 Gb/sec. He also worked on design and manufacturing of LED for commodity product. He is an expert for developing LCR Model of packages and interconnects. In the year 2000 he was elected as Fellow of IEEE for contributions on Electrical packaging of IC Chips. In addition, Professor Bhattacharyya has published 50nos. of papers and 26 patents to give an exposure of technical knowhow to the researchers world-wide. Since, 2013 he is serving as Professor at NIT, Agartala and is involved in profound research and academic growth. Within his stay at NIT, Agartala, he has published 5 IEEE transactions and filed 5 patents. His vast experience in the specialization of design, packaging and understanding of circuits will help the Electronics & Communication Engineering Department to boost academic as well as research activities.
- 3. **Professor Isha T B** (DOB: 12th August, 1959) Professor Isha is serving at Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham since 2nd January, 2008. She has obtained M.Tech degree from NIT Calicut and PhD from IIT, Kharagpur. She has served at many organizations like NERIST Arunachal Pradesh, Govt. Engineering College-Trichur etc in various capacities and has published 18 nos. of papers in journal and 43 nos. in conferences. Till now she has guided 23 students in B.Tech and 33 in M.Tech. 01 Ph.D has been completed under her guidance and 5 are ongoing. Her research interests include power electronics and drive, machine analysis. Her expertise in the field of power electronics and drive, machine analysis will help in growth of the Electrical Engineering Department in both academic as well as research activities.

It is proposed that the above mentioned Professors / Scientists will be engaged as Professor on contract with consolidated pay as per 7th CPC in last serving institute with the following facilities:

- [ii] Free medicine and medical insurance if applicable will be provided.
- [iii] Joining TA will be provided
- [iv] If engaged in any administrative job reimbursement will be made as per rules.

Item No: 21.42.: According approval of 512 Mbps leased line service from Jio

National Institute of Technology Arunachal Pradesh has 1Gbps Internet connectivity provided by NKN since 2013, for most of the year (about 9 months out of12), the link days disconnected for numerous reasons: heavy rainfall, landslides, power cuts at PoPs, fibre breakage due to road construction, etc. The report of downtime I enclosed with this letter. As a result, network connection stays unused. Consequently, students cannot study and research online, faculty members cannot perform educational tasks and staff are unable to do official duties required by them. Hence, the people of the entire Institute suffer from sub-optimal productivity levels. Moreover, administrative tasks remain stalled and communication with MHRD is disrupted and irregular, affecting the state of the Institute.

As an alternative, one proposal is received from Jio for 100Mbps Lease Line. The justification for this new 100Mbps Lease Line is given below:

- 1. Due to non-availability or unstable 1Gbps NKN line, many a time NIT Arunachal Pradesh missed very important as well as urgent meetings through Video Conferencing with different Ministry or other organizations. Our organization was unable to join the meeting for TEQIP with Ministry due to non-availability of Internet connection. Many placement drives got disrupted due to non-availability of Internet connectivity.
- 2. Although NIT Arunachal Pradesh is having 1Gbps connectivity for about 1000 peoples this new leased line will be used as a backup line for some of the sections like Administration (Director's Office, Registrar's Office, Account Section, Placement Cell etc), faculty, research Scholars and mainly for VC meetings so that official works, as well as research works, can go on smoothly.
- 3. 1Gbps NKN line originates from NIC Itanagar which is around 20km away from NIT Arunachal Pradesh where the four-lane construction is under construction and the new JIO Leased Line (Overhead Line) will come from JIO tower located at ITI campus which is very near (approx. 200 to 300 meter). So the fibre breakage probability is almost nil and this line can work as a stable backup line. Finally, when NIT Arunachal Pradesh will shift to its permanent campus this Lease Line will also be shifted.
