**NOTIFICATION**

Owing to reporting of few COVID-19 positive cases and to strengthen the Covid Support System, a Covid Care Unit (CCU) has been established in the Institute near **Central Workshop (Academic Block-01)**. The Covid Care Unit (CCU) shall be managed by the **Covid Task Force** by observing latest Covid-19 protocol issued by the Government, Health Department and other appropriate authorities which has been constituted with following members:

The Covid Task Force and the Covid Care Unit (CCU) will serve as a composite support system to deal with Covid-19 management in the Institute Campus by arranging Covid-19 testing, providing of Ambulance service, Food, Nursing care, Medical consultation/ referral (if needed), in addition to provide basic Quarantine facility in Covid Care Unit (CCU) for mild Covid-19 infection cases and also for isolation of people in the Campus who are found primary contact of the infected.

All students and Faculty members and Staff are also requested to observe strictly following Covid-19 protocols of the Institute:

- A. Covid-19 protocol for students:** All students arriving from outside in NIT Arunachal Pradesh Campus shall have to report first in the Medical Unit of the Institute, where initial Covid-19 test will be conducted.

In case of positive (+) result after initial Covid-19 test, they may return back from the Institute or remain in the Covid Care Unit (CCU) of the Institute till their result found negative (-). Those who are found negative in initial Covid-19 test shall have to go for isolation for 5 (five) days and after which mandatory Covid-19 test will be conducted.

- B. Covid protocol for Faculty and staff members:** Faculty and Staff members of the Institute residing inside the Campus (with the family, if any) travelling from outside the Arunachal Pradesh by **public transport/Air**, have to report mandatorily in Medical Unit of the Institute immediately of their arrival and undergo mandatory Covid-19 test. If the result of the test is found positive (+), they may stay in their residence in isolation for 7 (seven) days or till tested with negative (-). Those Faculty members and Staff (with their family, if any) tested negative during initial Covid-19 test, have to stay in isolation till 5 (five) days and after which they have to undergo mandatory Covid-19 test.

**In order to prevent spread of COVID-19 cases inside the NIT Arunachal Pradesh Campus entry of outsiders is temporally restricted until further order.** Officer in-charge, Security of the Institute is requested to instruct the Security personnels posted in the entry gate to follow it strictly.

Engineering Cell must ensure providing of sufficient sanitizer and cleaning staff in all buildings, medical unite, Covid Care Unit (CCU) from the Outsourcing Agency to ensure the maintenance of clean and hygienic environment.

Chief Warden of the Institute is requested to make necessary arrangement regarding Beds and other items which may be required in the Medical Unit as well as in CCU including food for Covid-19 positive students admitted in CCU.
