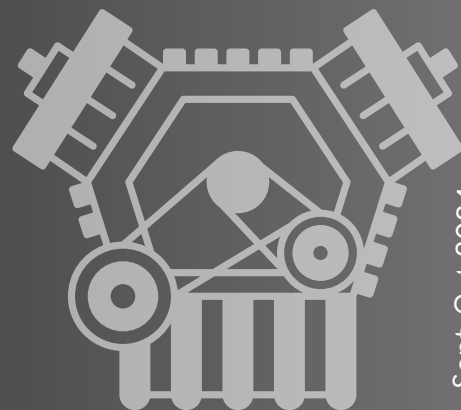
A Courtesy Call by Shri Subhash Kumar, the Chairman of the Board of Governors

Visit and Interaction of Chief Secretary of Arunachal Pradesh

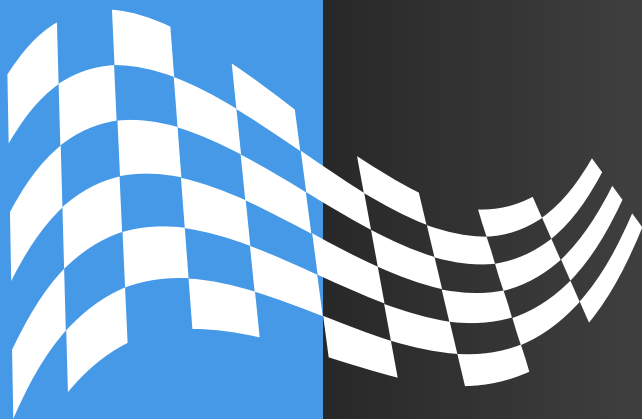

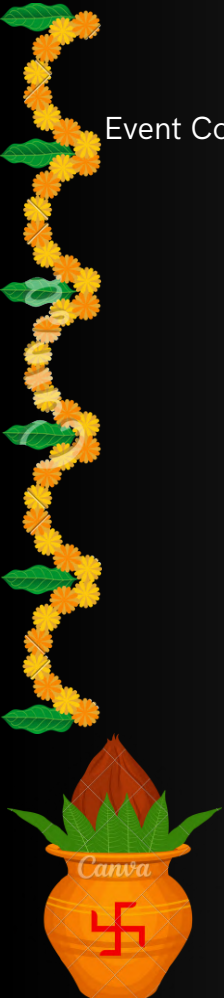
