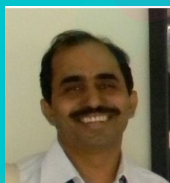

The former Prime Minister Manmohan Singh, on February 26, 2012, declared December 22 as the National Mathematics Day to mark the mathematician's birth anniversary. Srinivasa Ramanujan, who is also known as the 'man who knew infinity', did not receive any formal education in Mathematics but made important contributions to the field of mathematics.
